The Town of 1770 is the closest mainland point to Lady Musgrave Island.

The Spirit of 1770 is the quickest access to the island, only 75 minutes by sea, which allows 6 hours to explore the Outer Reef.

Lady Musgrave Island & Lagoon is a true coral cay with an unspoiled island and unique coral lagoon on the Outer Great Barrier Reef. Lady Musgrave National Park is a tropical paradise abundant in pisonia forests and bird life. The island is set on 3000 acres of living reef with a deep water coral lagoon which is unique to the entire Great Barrier Reef Region. The Spirit of 1770 enters the calm waters of the coral lagoon to moor only 300 metres from the island. This provides a protected haven for all age groups to explore the wonders of a living reef eco-system and the colorful variety of marine life - **all in one great day!**

New "Spirit of 1770" has just been launched - cruise in sheer comfort aboard our new purpose built 22 metre Catamaran which provides an excellent ride in aircraft style seating on the main deck and upper deck. The vessel is fully air-conditioned with forced fresh air vents for passenger comfort while traveling at sea.

Today the area is unspoiled and secluded. There is very little change since Captain Cook first landed in Queensland on 24th May, **1770** - over 200 years ago! The Town of 1770 and its adjoining town of Agnes Water is surrounded by unspoiled white sandy surf beaches, national parks, magnificent ocean views from the coastline, rocky headlands and pristine estuaries.

Activities in the area include swimming, surfing, 4WD hire, scuba diving courses, snorkeling, reef fishing, estuary fishing, beach and rock fishing, dinghy hire, mud crabbing, boating, water skiing, canoeing, windsurfing, horse riding, sailing charters, amphibious vehicle tours, houseboats, plus various other activities.
